	Medium-bodied dry white wine in pale yellow color. Aromas of grapefruit, herbs, lemonade and passion fruits. Positive acidity offers freshness and fruitiness flavours in finish.

	<p>Wonderfully seductive on the nose, it unleashes red and blackberry fruit aromas, enhanced with a hint of delicately spicy oak. Initially supple on the attack, the wine is rounded on the palate, and the aromas evolve harmoniously against the beautifully balanced tannic structure. The wine finishes on a long, flavorsome and slightly smoky note.</p>

	<p>Medium-bodied dry red wine in ruby red color. Aromas of spices, plum and black currant. Soft tannins structure combined with ripe black fruits and hints of pepper. Well-balanced wine in fruity finish.</p>

	<p>Very ripe on the nose, fleshy and wonderfully intense, revealing roasted mocha notes. Well-balanced, with fine and rounded tannins which are evident but not at all aggressive.</p>
